TRANSPORTATION & LODGING OPTIONS

FROM SEA-TAC AIRPORT

The airport is about 20 minutes south of downtown Seattle and 30 minutes from the UW Campus.

SHUTTLE EXPRESS | 1.800.487.RIDE

UW door-to-door service from airport to campus, \$36, with discounts for booking round-trip shuttle service.

SOUND TRANSIT LINK LIGHT RAIL

The light rail system will quickly and inexpensively transport you from the airport to the UW campus (about 44 minutes with trains departing every 6-10 minutes). \$3.25.


