


Connecting to Display

1. Connect your device to the display using the USB-C cable attached to the control panel.
2. Once connected, select "BYOD Mode" on the control panel. This allows your device screen to be shown on the large monitor.
3. Disconnect your device when finished.



Host Zoom Meeting from Your Device (BYOD Mode)


1. Start your Zoom meeting on your device.
2. Select "Join" on the control panel.
3. Enter the MeetingID for your Zoom meeting on the panel and admit the "Room" to your meeting.
4. The room becomes a participant in your meeting. You can make the room the "host" of the meeting and use its audio and video.
5. Make sure the meeting is ended on both your device and on the control panel when you are finished.



Host Zoom Meeting from Room Control Panel

(Required for non-USB-C compatibility)

1. Select "New Meeting" on the control panel.
2. Select "Join a Meeting" within the Zoom application on your device.
3. Enter the Zoom MeetingID provided by the control panel and join the meeting.
4. The control panel "runs" the Zoom meeting, and audio and video come from the system.
5. End the meeting from the control panel when you are finished.



Connecting to In-Room Audio and Video

In your virtual meeting application, select the "Rally Bar" audio and video options to use the in-room camera, microphone, and speakers.
